

Services for Persons who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing seeking Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Services

Support is available to Detox and Residential Facilities admitting individuals with a hearing loss

Coordination of Communication Access Services for Addiction Provider Agencies - Upon request, coordination of communication access services, such as Sign Language Interpreters or captioning via Computer-Assisted Real-time Translation (CART) services, for NJ Division of Addiction Services Licensed Treatment Programs or hospitals involved in direct treatment of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Other Drugs (ATOD).

Partial Funding for Communication Services - In an effort to empower agencies across New Jersey to comply with Title III of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), communication services will be provided on a sliding scale fee-for-service basis, based on agency policy. This may include the matching of funds or in-kind donation of services depending on financial need. Our agency will work with you to determine which services are best for the Deaf and hard-of hearing consumer.

Interpreters for 12-Step Meetings/Recovery Support – Provides coordination of qualified sign language interpreters and other modes of communication accessibility at 12-step meetings and other self-help recovery support meetings throughout the State. Clients who are released from Detox or Rehabilitation services are encouraged to attend self-help recovery support meetings on arrival home. Any individual or organization may contact us for existing locations and may also request an interpreter for a meeting in your area (including Al-Anon for other family members needing support).
