Number of faculty/staff within district	Cost per faculty/staff inclusive of all four courses
• 1-500 seats:	\$7.50 per faculty and staff member
• 501-750:	\$6.50 per faculty and staff member

Web-based faculty in-service instruction

Prevention First will work with school districts to define any custom requirements inclusive of course selection, user definitions, generation of reports, and real-time access via the Web.

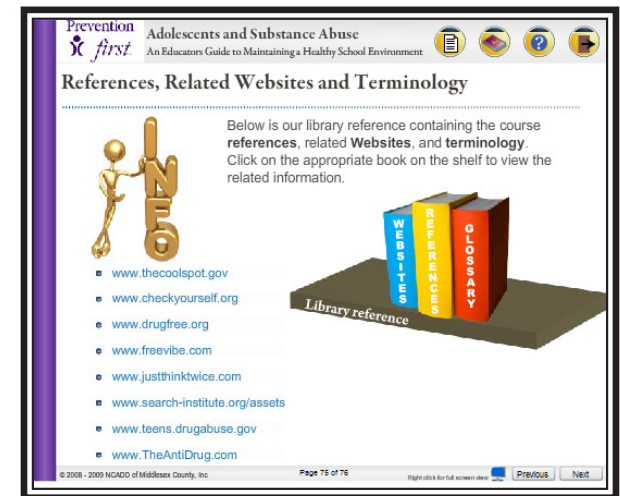
Prevention First will deliver an eLearning platform that can be easily and smoothly implemented in your school district. Our agency has developed a "How To" guide that includes:
